

## 2 ACT MINISTRIES TINY HOME COMMUNITY



### Mission :

To provide a safe welcoming environment for those facing homelessness who have a strong desire to rebuild their lives. Our goal is to provide enough time for residents to transition into permanent housing, stable income, a relationship with Jesus, and learn the core values of Christian living. Residents will be permitted to reside on the property until they have sufficient funds to make the transition to permanent housing and will receive mentorship to develop life skills necessary to stay off the streets

**This will be a clean and sober community and all residents will be required to pass a drug test upon entry in addition to random drug tests during their residency. This tiny home community will NOT BE for severe addicts, alcoholics, or people being released from prison.** This is temporary housing for people looking to develop permanent skills necessary for success in life. There will be a staff manager living on property and several staff overseeing all operations.

Residents will spend time volunteering in the community, in the neighborhood doing clean up and attending church or small group meetings to learn about Jesus as a part of their weekly routine. You don't need to be a Christian to come into the tiny home community, but we will ask that residents have an open mind to what Jesus can do in their lives.

2 Act Ministries will be doing outreach in the neighborhood to continue assisting the homeless battling addictions, requiring housing assessments, and other resources. This will continue to be conducted through mobile outreach, not on the property. No hand-outs or outreach will be done on the property. There will be no homeless hanging around or about the property.
